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ABOUT DHANAMANJURI UNIVERSITY

University) was established on 6th April, 2018 under “The Dhanamanjuri University Act, 2017” through a notification in the Manipur Gazette published by the Department of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Manipur. It is located at the heart of the Imphal City.

Dhanamanjuri University is a long cherished dream of our founding fathers and Maharani Dhanamanjuri. Manipur, an ancient kingdom, had a composite traditional system of education in the field of warfare, martial arts, games & sports, culture and many other schools of thought trained the people in various professional activities in ancient forms. The people have carried down this legacy of quest for knowledge and civilized existence since time immemorial. Ancient works of knowledge in the original scripts of Manipur stand as testimony to nurturing of the idea of a University in the minds of our forefathers and foremothers. Entrance test (ET) shall be conducted under the strict guidelines of the Dhanamanjuri University Examination Regulations.

A student is required to attend at least 75% of lectures delivered including practical (for students having practical) for appearing in the End-Semester Examination as a regular candidate.

ADMISSION PROCESS

The Admission Committee under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor, Dhanamanjuri University shall deal with all the matters relating to the admission process. The decision of the Committee in this regard shall be final and binding.

HOW TO APPLY

Prospectus along with application forms can be downloaded from the University website: www.dmu.ac.in . Duly filled-in application forms along with relevant documents should be submitted to the departments concerned of Dhanamanjuri University. Complete application should be accompanied by the proof of online transaction of *Rs. 500/-* for UR/OBC and *Rs. 300/-* for ST/SC/DAPs payable to Dhanamanjuri University, ICICI Bank. Incomplete applications or applications received after the last date of submission shall summarily be rejected. Students willing to apply in more than one subject should submit separate Application Forms and appear in the separate Entrance Examinations.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility Criteria for M.Sc./M.A./M.Com./M.P.E.S.

- a) Candidates seeking admission to M.Sc./M.A./M.Com. should have passed B.Sc./B.A./B.Com. (three years undergraduate programme) examination or equivalent thereto from any recognized Institution/University recognized by the UGC with 50% marks in the Honours/Major subjects for the unreserved (UR) category and 45% marks in the Honours/Major subjects for ST/SC/OBC/DAP/Sports candidates of Eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) /Children of Ex-Servicemen.
- b) Candidates who do not offer honours should offer the relevant subject as one of the electives in the undergraduate level and should secure 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in the subject concerned for the unreserved (UR) category and 45% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject concerned for ST/SC/ OBC/DAP/Sports candidates of eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) /Children of Ex-Servicemen.
- c) An Honours graduate may apply for admission to M.Sc./M.A./M.Com. programme in a subject which he/she offered as an elective/subsidiary subject in the undergraduate level. However, the candidate shall be treated as Non-Honours/Non-Major graduate.
- d) Non-Honours/Non-Major graduates seeking admission to M.Sc. Physics should have offered Mathematics as one of the elective subjects in B.Sc. (three years undergraduate programme).
- e) Candidates with Physics Honours in B.Sc. (three years undergraduate programme) or Non-Honours/Non-Major graduates who offered Physics as one of the elective subjects in B.Sc. (three years undergraduate programme) can also apply for admission to M.Sc. Electronics.
- f) Candidates seeking admission to M.Sc. Environmental Science should have passed B.Sc. (three years undergraduate programme) examination with honours in any subject or B.Sc. in Environmental Science or equivalent thereto from any recognized Institution/University recognized by the UGC.

- g) Candidates seeking admission to M.P.E.S. should have passed B.Sc. Physical Education, Health Education and Sports(3 years)/B.P.E.S. (3 years)/B.P.Ed. (4 years Integrated course)/B.P.Ed.(2 years course after graduation) from any recognized Institution/University recognized by the UGC with 50% marks in aggregate for unreserved (UR) category and 45% marks in aggregate for ST/SC/OBC/DAP/Sports candidates of Eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) /Children of Ex-Servicemen.
- h) Candidates seeking Admission to MA Education Programme should have completed BA (Three Year Under Graduate Programme) in Education from any Institute or University recognised by University Grants Commission (UGC), with a minimum of 50% of marks in aggregate in the Honours/Major Subject for unreserved (UR) category, and 45% of the marks in the Honours/Major Subjects for ST/SC/OBC/DAP/Sports candidates of eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) /child of Ex-Servicemen.
- i) Graduates who have offered Education as an Elective Subject till the final semester in the Under Graduate Programme is eligible for MA Education with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in the subject concerned for unreserved (UR) Category, and 45% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject concerned for ST/SC/OBC/DAP/Sports candidates of eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) /child of Ex-Servicemen.
- j) Candidates applying for admission to the M.Sc. (Electronics) programme must have completed B.Sc. Honours in Electronics (three-year undergraduate programme) from any UGC-recognized institution or university. A minimum of 50% marks in Electronics Honours/Major subjects is required for unreserved (UR) category candidates, while candidates belonging to ST/SC/OBC/DAP Sports candidates of Eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) /Children of Ex-Servicemen need to secure at least 45% marks in Electronics Honours/Major subjects.

- k) Candidates with Physics Honours or Instrumentation Science Honours in B.Sc. (three years undergraduate programme) securing at least 50% marks for unreserved (UR) category and 45% marks for reserved categories from any UGC-recognized institution or university or Non-Honours/Non-Major graduates who offered Electronics/Physics /Instrumentation Science as one of the elective subjects in B.Sc. Regular/pass course (three years undergraduate programme) securing at least 50% marks for unreserved category and 45% marks for reserved categories from any UGC-recognized institution or university can also apply for admission to M.Sc. Electronics. However, the candidates belonging to Non-Honours/ Non-Major graduates should offer and pass Mathematics in B.Sc. Regular/pass course (three years undergraduate programme).
- l) Candidates seeking admission to M.Sc Home Science with Food Science and Nutrition specialization should have passed B.Sc in Home Science Honours or as a major subject with minimum of 50%. Candidates seeking admission to M.Sc. Home Science with Human Development specialization should have passed B.A./B.Sc. in Home Science Honours or as a major subject with minimum of 50%. Candidates are to write either M.Sc. Home Science (Food Science and Nutrition) or M.Sc Home Science (Human Development) in the application form at the time of form submission. At present, the course is opened only for female candidates.
- m) Candidates seeking admission to M.Sc. in Anthropology should have passed three years undergraduate programme examination or equivalent thereto from any recognized Institution/University recognized by the UGC with 50% marks in Anthropology as Honours/Major subjects for unreserved category and 45% marks as the Honours/Major subjects for ST/SC/OBC/DAP/Sports candidates of Eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) /Children of Ex-Servicemen.
- n) Candidates applying for admission to the M.Sc. (Chemistry) program must have completed a B.Sc. (three-year undergraduate program) from any UGC-recognized institution or university. A minimum of 50% marks in chemistry Honours/Major subjects is required for unreserved category candidates, while candidates belonging to ST/SC/OBC/DAP Sports candidates of Eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) /Children of Ex-Servicemen need to secure at least 45% marks in chemistry Honours/Major subjects.

Candidates who did not offer Honours in Chemistry must secure at least 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in Chemistry for the unreserved category, and candidates belonging to ST/SC/OBC/DAP/Sports candidates of Eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) /Children of Ex-Servicemen must secure a minimum of 45% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in Chemistry. Non-Honours/Non-Major candidates applying for admission to the M.Sc. (Chemistry) program must have taken Physics or Mathematics as one of their elective subjects during their three-year B.Sc. undergraduate program.

- o) Eligibility criteria for LL.M. : A graduate in law from any University recognized by the Central and State Law or deemed University or a Foreign University recognized as being at par with an Indian University shall be eligible to apply for admission to the LL.M. 1st Semester provided, he/she has obtained a minimum aggregate of 50% marks for unreserved category and 45 % mark for reserved categories ST/SC/OBC/DAP/Sports candidates of Eminence (National/International level, subject to the verification by the Director of Sports, DMU) /Children of Ex-Servicemen computed on the basis of the performance of all the LL.B. degree examinations.

- p) Candidate seeking admission to M.A./M.Sc. Mathematics should have passed B.A./B.Sc. (three years undergraduate programme) examination with honours in mathematics from a recognised University. Bachelor' s degree with at least three (03) Courses each of one-year duration or six (06) Courses each of one semester duration in Mathematics from a recognised University.

MODE OF SELECTION

a. Selection will be made purely on the basis of total marks obtained in the Written Entrance Examination and weightages* subject to the verification of original documents.

*Weightages:

- Three marks shall be given to those students who have opted Honours or Major Subject in B.A./B.Sc./B.P.E.S./B.Com./LL.B.
- Two marks shall be given to those students who have participated in NSS camp/passed NCC (C certificate) Course/participated in any Swachh Bharat Programme organised by the Institute/College concerned.

b. Scheme of written Entrance Examination (M.A./M.Sc./M.P.E.S./M.Com./LL.M.)

- Multiple Choice Type Questions carrying 2 marks each.
- Full Marks – 100
- Number of Questions: 50
- Syllabus of the Written Entrance Examination shall be of Degree level of the subject concerned.
- Duration of Written Entrance Examination will be of 2 hours only.
- Candidates should bring the Admit Card on the day of Entrance Examination.
- No candidates will be allowed to sit in the Written Entrance Examination without the Admit Card.

c. The Admission Committee shall decide the minimum marks of provisional eligibility for admission to PG Course as per the overall result of the Entrance Examination of that particular subject.

d. Candidates securing below the minimum eligible marks in the entrance Examination shall not be allowed admission even in the eventuality of vacancies, however, the Admission Committee reserves the right for the final decision.

e. The Admission Committee reserves the right for rechecking/re-evaluation of the Answer Scripts as and when required.

f. FOR M.P.E.S.:

Scheme of Examination shall be –

Written Examination : 50 marks (25 questions of 2 marks each)

General Fitness test : 40 marks

Aptitude test : 10 marks

- Bonus marks will be awarded to the following categories of Sports persons:

a. International Level : 10 marks

b. National Level : 5 marks

c. State Level : 2 marks

All other criteria mentioned in the Mode of Selection will also apply to M.P.E.S.

- g. Selection of candidates for admission to LLM 1st Semester shall be based on the merit-list prepared on the consolidated marks secured in the Written Test & Viva-Voce.

RESERVATION

- Out of the available intake capacity of seats, 31% will be reserved for ST, 17% for OBC, and 2% for SC.
- Reservation of candidates belonging to Differently Able Persons (DAP), Sports Persons of Eminence (National/International Players), Children of Ex-servicemen shall be on horizontal basis, i.e. their reservation shall be within their original categories (for M.A./M.Sc. /M.Com. only).
- The University may entertain any other reservation from time to time as decided by the Academic Council; however, no other reservation/quota systems other than those officially applicable as per rules.
- As per office order no. 3/5/2018-DMU/Misc(Pt-I)/24 dated 05-09-2024, 50% of seats will be reserved for the candidates belonging to the Dhanamanjuri University for the Academic Session 2024-25.
