No.3/DMU/SOC-DBS/PhD/2025: In accordance with the resolutions taken by the members of the Department Board of Studies (DBS), Department of Sociology, Dhanamanjuri University, Manipur in its meeting held on 11/02/2025, it is to notify for information to all concerned that the Qualifying Entrance Test for admission to the Pre-PhD programme in Sociology for the academic session 2024-25 at Dhanamanjuri University, Manipur will be held as per the schedule/information given below:


A. Qualifying Entrance Test/QET (Written)

1. Date of qualifying entrance test: : 20th February, 2025
2. Full marks : 100 Marks
3. Question types :a. Multiple choice questions(MCQs) :80 Marks
:b. Descriptive questions :20 Marks
4. Number of MCQs : 40 (each question carries 2 marks)
5. Number of descriptive questions : 02 (10 marks each)
6. Duration of Test : 2.00 hours (10.00 AM to 12.00 Noon)
7. Venue of Test : Department of Sociology, DMU, Manipur
8. Issue of Admit Cards : 12th Feb. to 17th Feb. 2025 (during office hours)

- B. The Qualifying Entrance Test (QET) will be based on the syllabus of the postgraduate level.
- C. The QET qualifying marks will be 50% of the full marks.
- D. The QET is a qualifying test only and marks secured in the QET shall not be considered for final selection.
- E. The qualified candidates in the QET will appear at the seminar/interview/viva-voce for admission to the Pre-PhD programme.
- F. The date for the seminar/interview/viva-voce will be notified later.
- G. The final selection of candidates for admission to the Pre-PhD programme shall be based on the total marks secured in the seminar/interview/viva-voce.
- H. The number of seats for admission to the Pre-PhD programme shall be subject to the qualifying marks secured by the candidates in the seminar/interview/viva-voce.
