
A. Qualifying Entrance Test/QET (Written)

1. Date of qualifying entrance test :26th February, 2025
2. Full marks :100 Marks
3. Question types :Multiple choice questions(MCQs) 100 Marks
4. Number of MCQs :50 (each question carries 2 marks)
5. Duration of Test :1 Hour 30 Minutes (10:00 AM to 11:30 AM)
6. Venue of Test : Department of History, DMU, Manipur
7. Issue of Admit Cards :17th Feb. to 21st Feb. 2025 (11 AM to 2 PM)

- B. The Qualifying Entrance Test (QET) will be based on the syllabus of the postgraduate level.
- C. The QET qualifying marks will be 50% of the full marks.
- D. The QET is a qualifying test only and marks secured in the QET shall not be considered for final selection.
- E. The qualified candidates in the QET will appear at the seminar/interview/viva-voce for admission to the Pre-PhD programme.
- F. The date for the seminar/interview/viva-voce will be notified later.
- G. The final selection of candidates for admission to the Pre-PhD programme shall be based on the total marks secured in the seminar/interview/viva-voce.
- H. The number of seats for admission to the Pre-PhD programme shall be subject to the qualifying marks secured by the candidates in the seminar/interview/viva-voce.
