

ABOUT DHANAMANJURI UNIVERSITY

Dhanamanjuri University (D.M. University) was established on 6th April, 2018 under “The Dhanamanjuri University Act, 2017” through a notification in the Manipur Gazette, published by the Department of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Manipur.

Dhanamanjuri University is a long-cherished dream of its founding fathers. It came into existence as Dhanamanjuri College, popularly known as D.M. College in the year, 1946 under the patronage of the late Maharani Dhanamanjuri Devi, the Maharani & Consort of His Highness Maharaja Sir Churachand Singh, KCSI CBE, of Manipur.

Manipur, an ancient kingdom, had a composite traditional system of education in the field of warfare, martial arts, games & sports, culture, and many other schools of thought. People were trained in various professional activities in ancient forms. This legacy of quest for knowledge has been in existence since antiquity and will live for generations. Ancient works on knowledge in archaic Manipuri scripts stand as testimony to nurturing the idea of a university in the minds of our forefathers and foremothers. The state has celebrated the tradition of a purely intellectual pursuit which conserves the original ethos of the land and its people while being receptive to progressive changes in the course of time.

The University, under the National Scheme of Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), is built up of five constituent colleges, namely, Dhanamanjuri College of Science (D.M. College of Science), Dhanamanjuri College of Arts (D.M. College of Arts), Dhanamanjuri College of Commerce (D.M. College of Commerce), Ghanapriya Women’s College (G.P. Women’s College) and Lairenmayum Sheibyashachi Law College (L.M.S. Law College), all of which occupy common, adjoining, or neighbouring physical spaces.

Dhanamanjuri University is situated at the heart of Imphal city and the campus is bounded by National Highway No. 2 in the East, Thangmeiband Road in the West & North, and the Naga River in the South. Ghanapriya Women’s College is located at the South West of Kangla, the ancient capital of Manipur, near the Raj Bhavan, and L.M.S. Law College is located facing eastern boundary of the main campus right across the National Highway No. 2.

ADMISSION PROCESS

The Admission Committee under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor, Dhanamanjuri University, Manipur shall deal with all the matters relating to admission. The decision of the committee in this regard shall be final and binding.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. For the academic year, 2026-27, admission to all PG programmes of Dhanamanjuri University will be done through entrance test only.
2. If a candidate fails to meet the eligibility criteria as per the requirement of any particular program, his/her candidature will not be considered at all.
3. Incomplete applications shall be summarily rejected.
4. The candidates are required to pay the application fees for each programme selected.
5. Application forms should be submitted online, at <https://www.dmu.ac.in>, with the fee of Rs. 500/- (General & OBC) and Rs. 300/- (SC, ST & PWD).
6. Application Forms and E-Prospectus will be made available online. Physical copies will not be provided.
7. After online submission, a print-out/hard copy of the form along with the enclosures should be submitted to the department concerned.

COURSES OFFERED

ELIGIBILITY & INTAKE CAPACITY

The University offers admission to postgraduate courses in various Departments of Studies that fall under seven different Schools of Studies. Students who passed B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.B.A./B.P.E.S./B.P.Ed./L.L.B. or equivalent qualifying examination from a recognised university/institute are required to apply online for the same. Selection of candidates will be done purely on merit through entrance test or as decided by the authority.

Note: Sports Persons of Eminence (SPE) Certificate should be uploaded after due verification by the Assistant Director of Sports, Dhanamanjuri University, Manipur.

MODE OF SELECTION

- a. Selection will be based purely on the total marks obtained in the Written Entrance Examination plus the Weightages defined hereunder, subject to verification of academic credentials.

Weightages:

- Three marks to be awarded to those students who did their degrees with Honours/Major in the subject to which PG admission is sought.
 - Two marks to be awarded to those students who took part in NSS Camp/passed NCC (C certificate) Course/participated in any Swachh Bharat Programme, organised by the institute/college concerned.
- b. Scheme of Entrance Examination (**M.A./M.Sc./M.P.E.S. /M.Com./LL.M.**)
- Multiple Choice Type Questions carrying 2 marks each.
 - Full Marks – 100
 - Number of Questions: 50
 - Syllabus of the Written Examination shall be that of Bachelor's Degree or equivalent level.
 - Duration of Written Examination will be 2 hours.
 - No candidate without Admit Card will be allowed to sit in the Written Examination.
- c. The Admission Committee shall decide the minimum qualifying marks/provisional eligibility for admission on the basis of the overall performance of the candidates in the entrance test for that particular subject.
- d. Candidates failing to reach the minimum qualifying marks in the entrance examination will not be considered for admission even in the eventuality of vacancies. The Admission Committee, however, reserves the right to make the final decision.
- e. The Admission Committee reserves the right to allow or deny the pleas for rechecking/re-evaluation of the answer scripts.
- f. For M.P.E.S, the scheme of the entrance test is as follows:

RESERVATION POLICY

- Of the total number seats/intake capacity, 31% will be reserved for ST, 17% for OBC, and 2% for SC.
- Reservation of candidates belonging to Differently-Abled Persons (DAP), Sports Persons of Eminence (National/International Level), Children of Ex-servicemen shall be on horizontal basis, i.e. their reservation shall be within their original categories (for M.A./M.Sc. /M.Com. only).
- The University may entertain any other reservation from time to time as decided by the competent authority. However, in general, no other reservation/quota system is applicable other than those officially specified.

DECLARATION OF ENTRANCE TEST RESULT

There will be a combined merit list prepared for all the applicants of the subject concerned and followed by the List of selected candidates & Wait-Listed candidates after due consideration of the reservation policy specified above. The said Lists will be uploaded to the university website, www.dmu.ac.in, and will also be displayed on notice boards of the university and the departments concerned.

Selected candidates should visit the university website and get themselves enrolled in the course within the scheduled timeframe. Candidates failing to enroll within the stipulated time window shall not be accorded a second chance.
