Notes:

1. The Qualifying Entrance Test (QET) will consist of 5 descriptive questions each carrying 10 marks, focussed on the Research methodology, and 25 multiple-choice questions each carrying 2 marks, based on subject-specific topics from the M.Sc. Physics syllabus of Dhanamanjuri University, Manipur.
2. Only candidates who qualify in QET and QET exempted candidates shall be allowed for Interview/Viva-voce for the final selection.

3. The minimum qualifying for the Interview/Viva-voce are 50% of the total marks of the QET for unreserved candidates and 45% for candidates in the SC/ST/OBC/EWS/Differently-abled categories.
4. The final selection of candidates will be based on 70% weightage from the entrance test and 30% from their performance in the Interview/Viva-voce.
